Last February 19, with the joint effort of the AN Home and other religious sectors in the community where AN is, we had Basics of Nonviolent workshop on Communication with the AN children and the youth from different churches (e.g. Catholic, Protestant, Born Again). Children of AN are not new to NVC, however, the young people who joined them are first-timers to NVC. According to these young people, they wished they had known NVC way before and hoped that NVC will be introduced not just to them but to all the young people who advocates for peace and social change.
